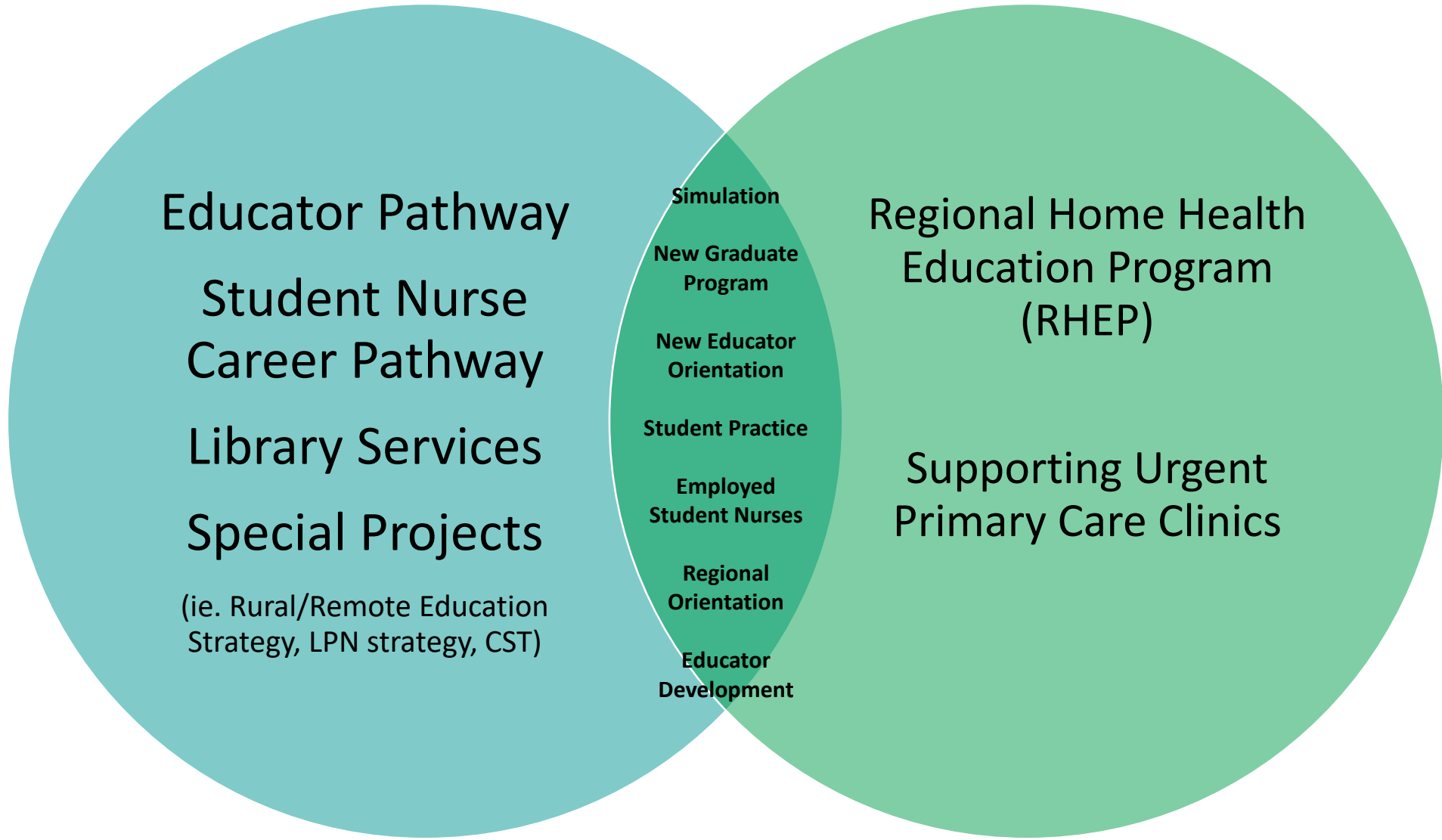

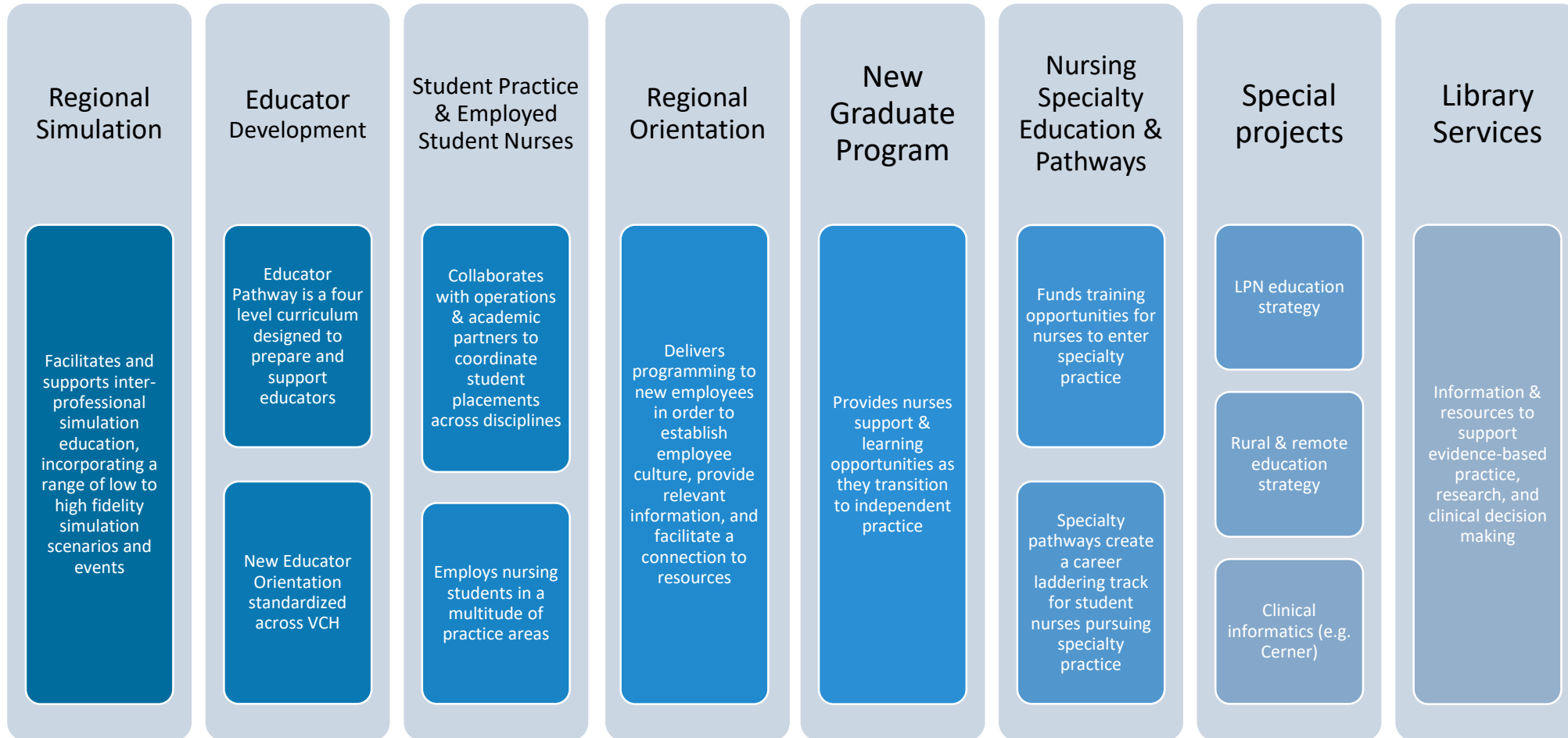

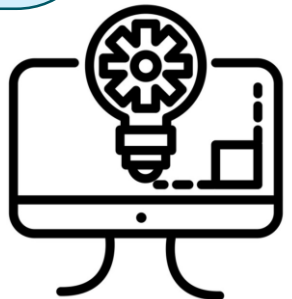


REGIONAL SIMULATION

- Low and high fidelity simulation scenarios/events

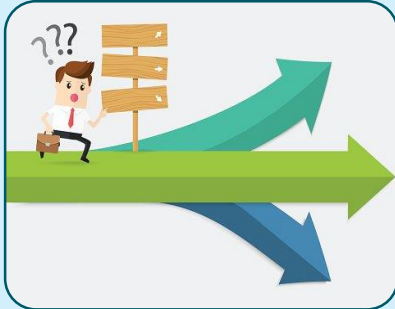


EDUCATOR DEVELOPMENT



Educator Pathway

- A four-level curriculum designed to prepare and support educators, both nursing and allied
- The program is based on best practice in the delivery of education and educational leadership
- For educators who want to enhance their knowledge and skills related to teaching and learning
- Partial sponsorship for staff pursuing a Master's degree that has a focus on adult education

Employed Student Nurse Program

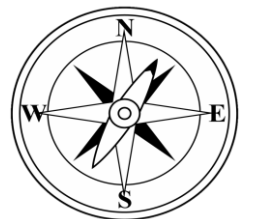
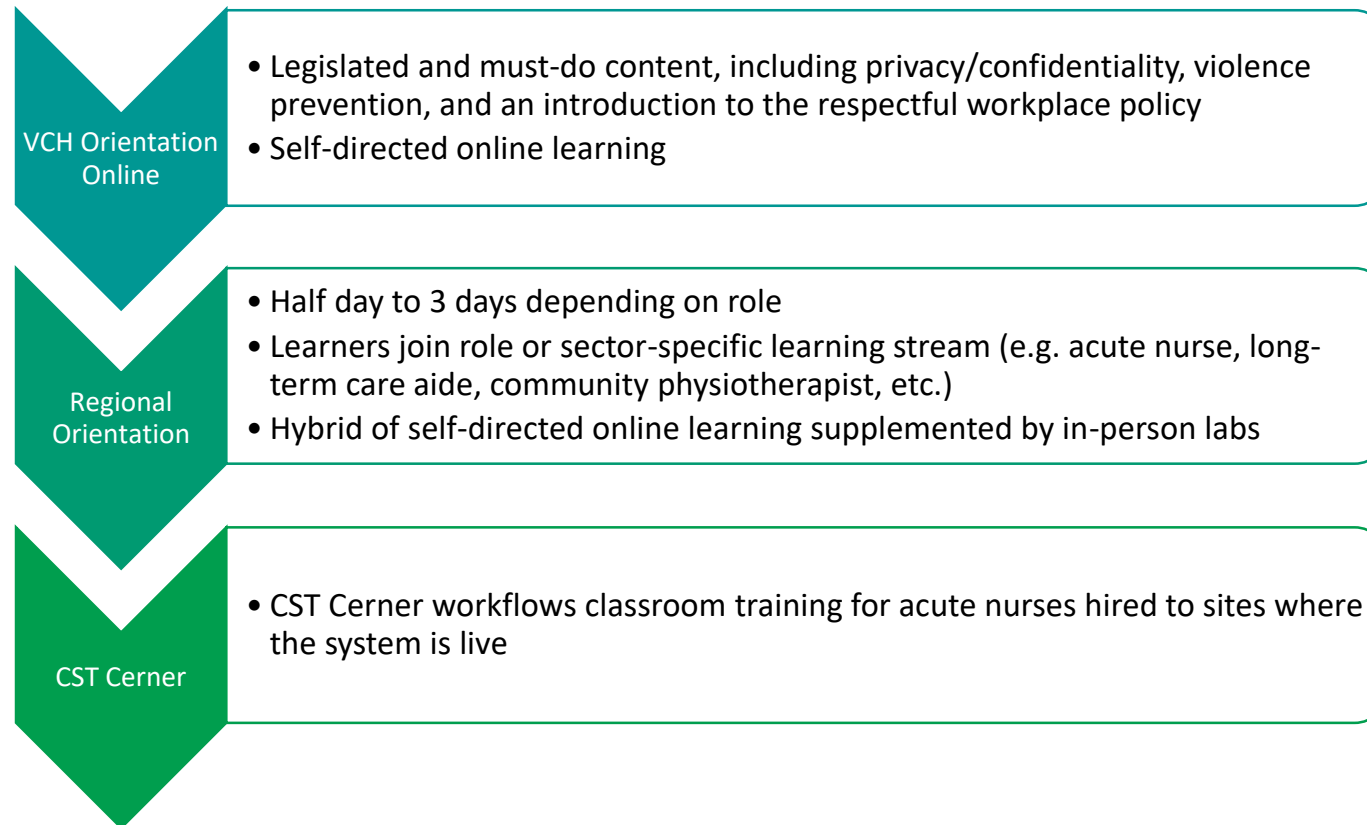
- Offers a unique employment opportunity for nursing and psychiatric nursing students to consolidate their skills in the real-life working environment, while building experience and relationships to ease their transition into the workforce as newly graduated nurses



REGIONAL ORIENTATION

- Delivers programming to new employees in order to establish employee culture, provide relevant information, and facilitate a connection to resources.

NEW GRADUATE PROGRAM

- Provides new graduate nurses support and learning opportunities to enhance their confidence and competence as they transition from student to independent practice
- RNs, LPNs, and RPNs who have graduated within the past 18 months from a school of nursing
- Main components of the program:

 - ✓ Workshops & Skills Days
 - ✓ Live in-services (on the units)
 - ✓ Panel forums (live and recorded)

Specialty Education

Funded training opportunities for nurses to enter specialty practice:

- BCIT: Critical Care (ICU, CSICU, CCU, Cardiac Cath, IR, PACU), Emergency, Pediatric Emergency, Renal, High Acuity, Perinatal, Neonatal
- Regional Perioperative Education Program (RPEP): in house operating room nurse training program

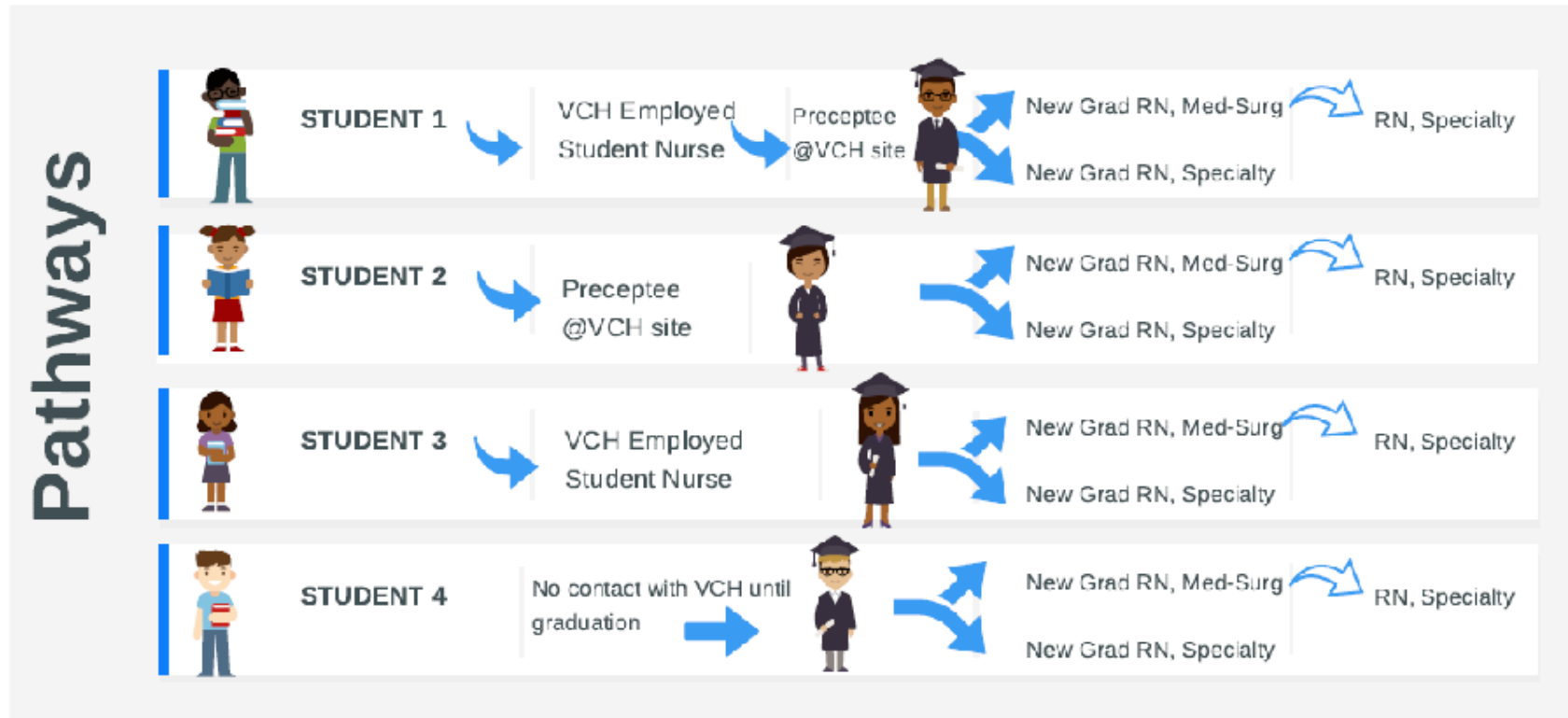

Student Nurse Career Pathway

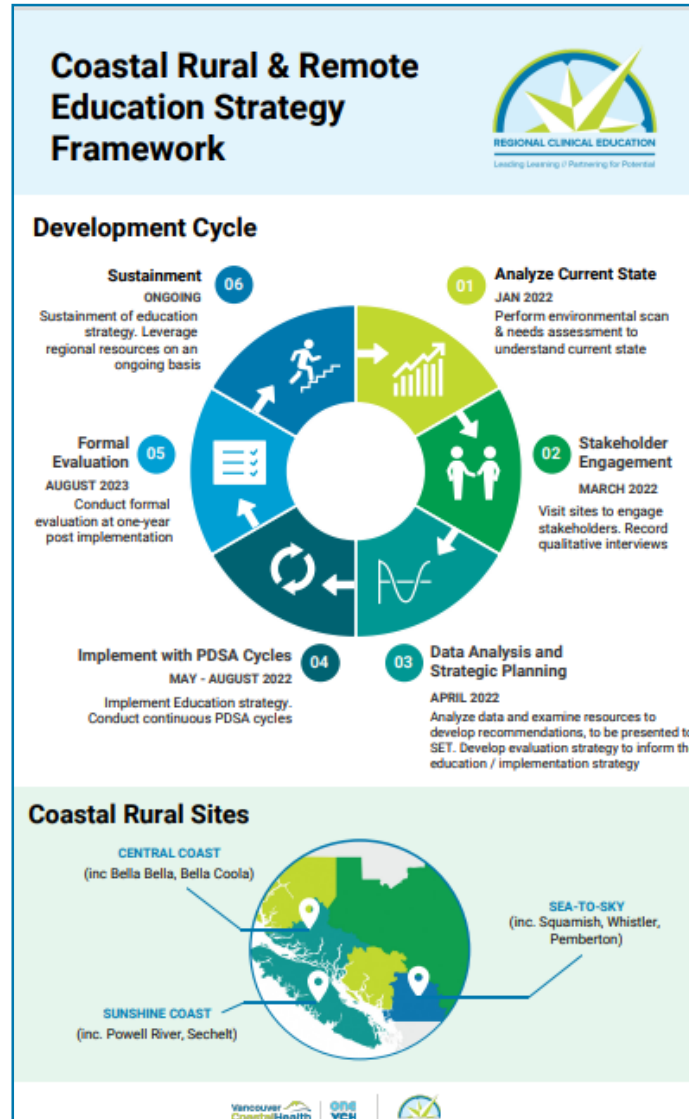
- Career laddering track for student nurses pursuing specialty practice
